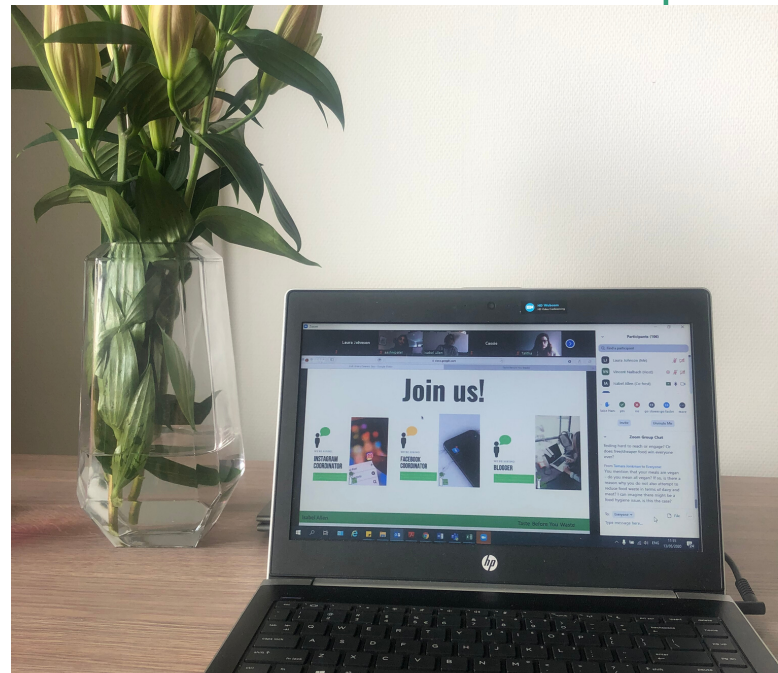

Political: Companies and organizations involved in the political process, which engage in advocacy and policy work on the local, national, and international level.

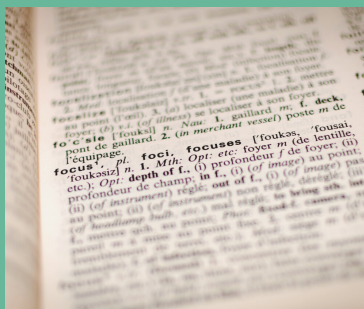


Social: Non-profit foundations, organizations, and associations, which focus on the social side of sustainability such as sustainable farming, struggle against overfishing or serving communities.

It channels the knowledge and advocates for the needs of local groups to improve the decision making processes on the national and international level. By connecting 'Both ENDS' it bridges the gap between a diverse set of actors, builds capacity on the grassroots level through the exchange of knowhow and financial support, and helps the establishment of coalitions on the global level. The working fields include: Climate justice; Human rights and gender; Land and water governance; Public finance for development; and Trade and investment.
